## DROCOM AND BY-LAWS ARE MAIN TOPICS AT JANUARY MEMBERSHIP MEETING

The importance of the Deed Restriction Oversight Committee (DROCOM) was a main topic of discussion at the General Membership Meeting held on Tuesday, January 17, 2012. James Beucle was elected as the new DROCOM chairman, and several members present volunteered to serve on the committee.

The proposed budget for 2012 was presented by treasurer Linda Lochli. This year's budget contains an allowance for legal fees, for services related to updating our civic association by-laws and putting in place guidelines prompted by recent state legislation. www.springbranchoaks.com - when they are completed, and a report will be presented at the April 17 General Membership Meeting.

Newly-elected councilwoman Helena Brown spoke briefly at the meeting and announced that she is opening an office in the facilities of Spring Branch Hospital for the convenience of constituents. Stop by if you have a compliment or concern, or would like to volunteer.

#### WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT TELEMARKETING CALLS

The National Do Not Call Registry gives you an opportunity to limit the telemarketing calls you receive. Once you register your phone number, telemarketers covered by the National Do Not Call Registry have up to 31 days to stop calling you.

To add your number to the Registry you can call 888-382-1222 from the phone you wish to register, or go to www.donotcall.gov and click on "Register a Phone Number" in the left column of the page. You can register your home and/or mobile. If you are not sure whether you have already registered, click on "Verify A Registration." To report a violation, click on "File A Complaint." Telephone numbers placed on the National Do Not Call Registry will remain on it permanently due to the Do-Not-Call Improvement Act of 2007, which became law in February 2008.

Calls from or on behalf of political organizations, charities, and telephone surveyors would still be permitted, as would calls from companies with which you have an existing business relationship or those to whom you've provided express agreement in writing to receive their calls. However, if you ask a company with which you have an existing business relationship to place your number on its own do-not-call list, it must honor your request. You should keep a record of the date you make the request.
