Assessments

Each property owner will receive an absentee ballot and cover letter in the mail, explaining the rationale for setting our annual assessment at a higher rate. You may vote by mail, but we urge you to also attend the meeting to join the discussion. Final voting will take place then.

Board election

There will be three openings on the Board of Directors for 2015. Carolyn Schooley and Linda Lochli both have terms which expire this year. Their replacements will serve three-year terms. In addition, the spot vacated by Dan Hollingsworth needs to be filled. That will be a one-year term.

Please think about your neighbors who would make good officers and be willing to serve the neighborhood. There is no Nominating Committee this year, so all nominations will be made from the floor. Please be sure to have permission from anyone you wish to nominate!

DISTRICT A FAQ'S FROM BRENDA STARDIG

A recent newsletter from District A City Councilwoman Brenda Stardig listed a number of frequently asked questions her office receives. Here are some which come up in our neighborhood:

Trash collection Schedule



*Note special holiday pick-up dates

Thursday, September 25	5 Tree trash
Friday, October 3	Recycle
Friday, October 17	Recycle
Thursday, October 23	Junk trash
Friday, October 31	Recycle
Friday, November 14	Recycle
*Friday, November 28	Tree trash
*Saturday, November 29	Recycle & regular trash pick-up
Friday, December 12	Recycle
*Friday, December 26	Junk trash
*Saturday, December 27	7 Recycle & regular trash pick-up

1. Who do I call if there are cars parking in the yard in my neighborhood?

- Call 3-1-1
- HPD is responsible for enforcing this, but 3-1-1 can refer you to the correct place to contact.

2. A vehicle has been parked on my street for weeks. What do I do?

- Call the HPD non emergency number: 713-884-3131
- A vehicle is allowed to be parked on a the street for 24 hours. After 24 hours, HPD can write a ticket. After another 24 hours, another ticket can be issued. 24 hours later, the vehicle can be towed regardless of whether or not it is operable.

3. My drainage ditch needs to be cleaned out. Who do I call?

• If the ditch is in your yard, you are responsible for cleaning the ditch. If it is not on private property, then call it in to 3-1-1.

4. My trash (or recycling) was not picked up. Who do I call?

• First check your collection schedule to make sure that you put out your trash on the correct day. If you did put out your trash on the correct day, call 3-1-1 to report the problem.

[Remember that heavy trash may be put out any day the week it is collected, but regular trash and recycle should be <u>out of sight</u> until the day before collection.]

5. I have called 3-1-1 multiple times, but the problem still exists. What can be done now?

• When you call 3-1-1, they will give you a Service Request Number (SR#). Call my office at 832-393-3010 with the SR#, and my staff will assist you.
